#### 2. Is there an entrance exam for admission?

A: Some courses like B.Sc. Nursing, Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing require entrance exams like OJEE, while others offer direct admission based on merit. For government quota seats it is mandatory to come through centralized counseling but for management quota seats, the students can apply directly to the institute.

#### 4. What is the minimum and maximum age for admission?

A: The minimum age for admission is 17 years (for 12<sup>th</sup> pass course), and the maximum age limit varies depending on the course and regulatory guidelines (For GNM, B. Sc. Nursing- 35 years). Some courses whose duration is 6 months/ 1 year also allows class X students. For details please refer to the eligibility criteria in the table given above.

#### 5. Can students from outside Odisha take admission in JPIEE?

A: Yes, students from other states can take admission under the management quota in ANM, GNM, and all allied courses. However, they cannot take admission in government quota seats. Additionally, other state students are not eligible for the OJEE exam, which makes them ineligible for B.Sc. Nursing and Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing admission under both government and management quota seats. The rules keep amending every year so we request you to please visit government website and notification for further clarifications.

#### 6. Is the Odia 7th exam (MIL) mandatory for students from other states?

A: For government quota seats, passing the Odia 7th exam is mandatory. However, for management quota seats, it is not required.

#### 7. Is there an EMI option for fee payment?

A: Yes, EMI options on monthly basis are available for all courses.

#### 8. Are there any additional charges for EMI?

A: No, there are no additional charges for EMI.

#### 9. Can I book a seat in advance?

A: Yes, students can book a seat by paying advance deposit only in management quota.

#### 10. Is the advance booking amount adjusted in the course fee?

A: Yes, the advance booking amount is adjusted in the course fee at the time of admission, if student takes admission otherwise it is forefeited.

#### 11. Is the advance booking amount refundable if admission is not taken?

A: No, if the admission is not completed for any reason, the advance booking amount will be forfeited and is non-refundable.

#### 12. Can I book a seat if I have not yet completed the eligibility exam (10th or 12th)?

A: Yes, you can book a seat provisionally. However, admission will be confirmed **only after you pass the required eligibility exam** and submit the necessary documents.

#### 13. Does the institute help in getting an education loan?

A: Candidate can avail the Third-party study loan to pay the course fee. Students can obtain documents like fee structure, admission confirmation, and approval letters for loan processing.

#### 16. Can students avail treatment at JP Hospital at discounted price?

A: Yes, students are entitled to health benefits and treatment at JP Hospital as per institutional policies which includes medical dispensary facility, annul health checkup, Discounts on health services provided by JPHRC.

#### 17. Can a student's parent avail health benefits at JP Hospital?

A: Yes, students' parents can avail health benefits at JP Hospital as per the hospital's policies.

#### 18. What are the basic facilities are available in JPIEE?

A: The campus has modern classrooms, laboratories, library, transport, hostels, Conference Hall, security service and a cafeteria, etc.

#### 19. What kind of faculty and teaching staff are available at JPIEE?

A: JPIEE has highly competent and experienced teachers and faculty members. Additionally, visiting faculties and expert doctors also conduct classes, ensuring high-quality education and practical learning for students.

#### 20. Is hostel accommodation available?

A: Yes, separate hostels for boys and girls are available with all essential amenities.

#### 21. What is the cost of hostel accommodation?

**A:** The hostel fee is ₹36,000 per year. It includes all the three meals and transportation charges from hostel to institute and vice a versa.

#### 22. Is there an EMI option available for hostel fees?

A: Yes, students can opt for a monthly EMI payment option for hostel fees.

#### 23. Is hostel compulsory?

A: No, it is optional.

#### 24. Is food included in hostel fees?

A: Yes, hostel fees include food charges.

#### 25. What type of food is provided to students in the hostel?

A: The hostel provides pure vegetarian meals three times a day, including breakfast, lunch, and dinner. The meals are nutritious and well-balanced, containing all essential vitamins and minerals to ensure a healthy diet for students.

#### 26. Is uniform mandatory?

A: Yes, all students must wear the prescribed uniform and additional cost will be charged.

#### 27. What does the fee structure include and exclude or is there any hidden charges?

A: The fee structure

- **includes**admission fee, tuition fee, lab fee, library fee, transportation charges, practical training charges, and development fees.
- However, it **excludes** document verification fees, university registration fees, uniform fees, examination fees, and any other fees not explicitly mentioned in the inclusions.

#### 28. What is the cost of the uniform?

A: The cost of the uniform is ₹1000 per set. It may change from time to time.

#### 29. Is transportation provided for students?

A: Yes, transport facilities are available.

#### 30. Is transport fee included in the course fee?

A: Yes, no additional amount will be charged.

#### 31. What is the mode of fee payment?

A: The fees can be paid through Net Banking, Online Transfer, or other available online payment methods.

#### 32. What documents are required for admission?

A: Students must submit:

- 10th & 12th Mark Sheets& certificate
- Qualifying certificate
- Transfer Certificate/CLC (College leaving certificate)
- Aadhar Card
- Passport-size Photographs

Document requirements may vary based on the course, and students will be informed in advance if any additional documents are needed.

#### 33. What is the admission process?

A: Admission involves application submission, document verification, fee payment, and confirmation of enrollment.

#### 34. Is the admission process online or offline?

**A:** The admission process is**offline**. Students must visit the institute in person to complete the admission formalities.

#### 35. Is a medical fitness certificate mandatory for admission?

A: Yes, a medical fitness certificate is mandatory for admission to ensure that the student is physically fit for the course.

#### 36. Are scholarships available?

A: Government will give merit-based and need-based scholarships to student as per government guidelines. Students must apply with the required documents as per the government notification.

#### 37. Can students from other states avail scholarship benefits?

**A:** Yes, students from other states can avail **scholarship benefits from their own state**, as per their **respective government guidelines**. Students must apply for the scholarship through the appropriate channels.

#### 38. What are the college hours?

A: Classes typically run from 9 AM to 5 PM, which includes Theory and Practical sessions.

#### 39. What are the career opportunities after completing the course?

A: Students can pursue careers in hospitals, research institutions, pharmaceuticals, or higher studies in both and government and private.

#### 40. After course completion, can JPIEE students get job opportunities at JP Hospital?

**A:** Yes, **preference will be given** to JPIEE students for job opportunities at **JP Hospital**, based on **vacancies**, **eligibility**, **and performance**.

#### 41. Is the institute approved by regulatory bodies?

**A:** Yes, the institute is approved by

- a. INC (Indian Nursing Council)
- b. **ONMC** (Odisha nurses midwifery council)
- c. **DMET** (Directorate of Medical Education And Training)
- d. **OUHS** (Odisha University of Health Sciences)

and other regulatory bodies as applicable.

#### 42. What is the difference between management and government quota?

A: Government quota admissions are based on merit, entrance exams and through govt. counseling, while management quota seats are filled based on institutional norms. 85% seats are filled through government quota and 15% seats are filled through management quota. In case the seats in government quota remains vacant, it can be filled by the institute through management quota.

#### 43. Can I withdraw my admission after seat booking?

A: Yes, but all the money paid towards advance seat booking will be forfeited.

#### 44. Can I withdraw my admissionafter course has started?

A: Yes, you can withdraw your admission after course has started, the course fee paid towards all the completed years/ semester (6-month courses) will be forfeited. For the current year 50 % course fee will be charged. No refund in hostel fee/and other fee paid will be done.

#### 45. Can I change my course after admission?

**A:** No, you can only change your course **before admission**. Once admission is confirmed, the course cannot be changed.

#### 46. Will the original documents be retained by institute during admission?

A: Yes, the original documents will be retained by the institute during admission and will be returned after course completion.

#### 47. Do you offer distance education?

A: No, all courses are conducted in regular mode.

#### 48. What is the exam pattern?

A: Exams include written, practical, and viva assessments. This varies course to course.

#### 49. What is the total number of semesters for each course?

A: The number of semesters varies depending on the course. Below is the semester structure:

#### 50. What is the minimum attendance required for appearing exams?

A: Students must have at least 80% attendance in theory and practical.

#### 51. What is the pass mark?

A: Minimum 50% in theory and practical exams separately.

#### 52. What are the studying and teaching languages at JPIEE?

A: Classes are conducted in English, Hindi, and Odia for better understanding.

#### 53. In which language are the exams conducted?

**A: All exams** at JPIEE are conducted in **English** for most courses. However, for the **ANM course**, exams are conducted in **both English and Odia**.

#### 54. Is there any stipend during internship?

A: Yes, the stipend may be paid by the government to certain category of students as per the govt. policy and provisions at the time of student doing internship. There is no direct stipend payment from JPIEE at present.

#### 55. Where will students be trained for practical training?

A: Students will be trained at JP Hospital, CHCs, PHCs, and other affiliated hospitals like IGH.

#### 56. What is the anti-ragging policy of the institute?

A: Ragging is strictly prohibited. Strict action will be taken against violators. An Anti-Ragging committee is formed to ensure students issues are addressed promptly and fairly.

#### 57. What co-curricular activities are available at the institute?

A: The institute offers various co-curricular activities, including competitions (poster-making, quizzes, debates, and games), cultural programs (dance, singing, drama), sports events, and workshops. Students also actively participate in the Annual Function and other special programs, fostering overall development.

#### 58. What happens if a student fails in an exam? Is there any provision for re-examination?

**A:** Yes, students who fail in an exam can appear for a **supplementary exam**, as per the government rules and regulations.

#### 59. How many leaves are available in a year?

A: The total leave structure includes all Sundays, 50 days of vacation, 30 days of holidays, and 35 clinical observation days, as per the academic schedule.

#### 60. What safety and security facilities are available for students in the institute?

**A:** The institute ensures student safety through:

- 24×7 security service with guards on campus
- CCTV surveillance in key areas
- Proper fire-fighting system for emergencies
- Strict anti-ragging policy with monitoring committees
- Separate hostel facilities with security personnel
- Emergency medical support and first-aid availability
- ID card system for student identification
- Restricted entry for outsiders with visitor verification
