I came to Rourkela with a big trolley bag and a lot of hope. The first order of business was house hunting. As I was new to town, it was a bit of challenge but I could manage to get a room for rent near my work place. Here on out there were some downs and ups along the way. Let's just get on with the demerits first and how to deal with it.

One of the major concerns was the bridge, I had heard that the bridge gets very crowded (turns out not any more) and was a major factor in choosing a rented house near my workplace. The second concern was air pollution. I had bought my air-purifier, however; it turns out indoor air quality was only moderate (probably because of away and maybe upwind from the steel plant) and many times better than Bhubaneswar (yes, that's right!!). The next was high TDS in water which can be easily dealt with water purifier. Staying close to roads and passing by trains caused noise, which I didn't like and was dealt with by soundproofing foams on windows and doors. And that's it. That's all the demerits of Rourkela.

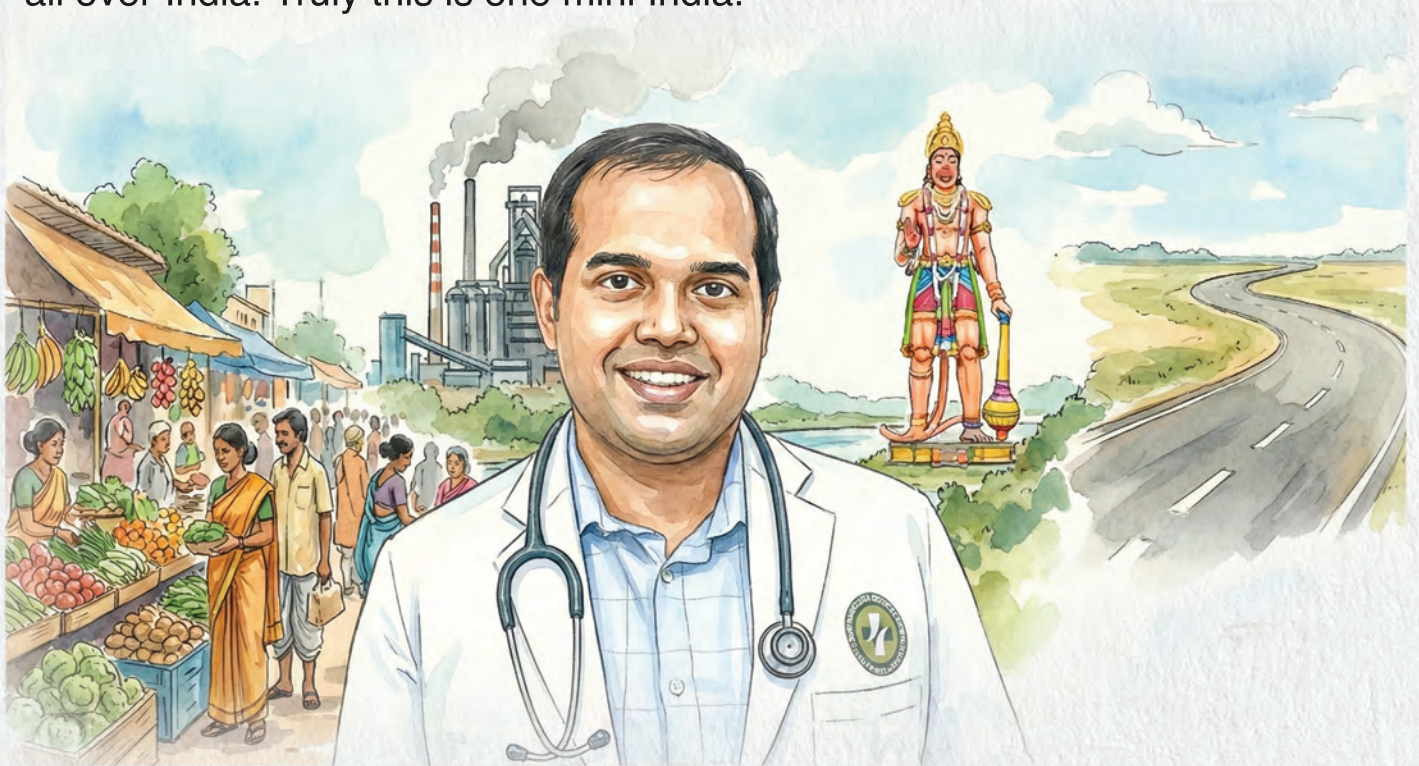
Now coming to the positive aspects, this article can't possibly incorporate all, but I will try to include all the major ones. First of all, the open roads. I like driving very much and the open roads, state highways with minimal traffic meant it's a delight for people who like driving. Many times, I would just go out for the feel of it only.

Second best thing is the local markets. The markets and local farmers bring the best, most fresh fruits and vegetables which I adore the most. Mind you, before Rourkela I was in Rajasthan for 3 years and let's say that fresh

fruits and veggies are a luxury around that part of the world. You want the freshest, juiciest most flavourful local oranges? Only 2 rs per fruit. Or say you want tender opinion leaves for garnishing, just right there at the corner in the market. You fancy say, strawberry, mangoes, papaya; you name it, its available in many varieties and cheap and fresh. Many times, I couldn't even identify (still now) stuff being sold in the local markets, such is the variety of items here.

The next best thing is people. The people around here are very amicable and helping in nature. Simple villagers many times offer produce from their farm after getting treatment, which is an achievement incomparable to any. Or say you treated one higher up official of a steel plant and you are invited to see the steel making process at the furnace (That you wanted to see from school time). There are people from all over India coming here to work, study, do business and just live life. I have met people from Rajasthan to Tamilnadu and from Simdega to Sambalpur. I once even treated one patient from abroad with reports in Spanish, and got brushed up and use my own Spanish skills.

Now coming to finding India, Rourkela is place where the weather will remind you the summer of the deserts of Rajasthan, the rains of Meghalaya, the winter will be so chilly as one not to miss the Kashmir. Rourkela is truly one metropolitan in Odisha with being melting pot of cultures, traditions from all over India. Truly this is one mini India.

This hour helps your mind feel lighter and calmer.

Sleep plays a major role in creating balance. Try to sleep and wake up at the same time every day. Good sleep acts like a power button for your brain—it makes you fresh, focused, and energetic. Finally, create a small weekend ritual, like planning the week ahead, organizing your room, or doing a hobby. These simple activities recharge your mind and prepare you for the coming days.

In the end, work–life balance is not about reducing your work. It is about living a healthier, peaceful, and well-managed life. When you give time to your work and also to yourself, you become more productive, confident, and happy. A balanced life is not difficult—it just needs small steps every day.

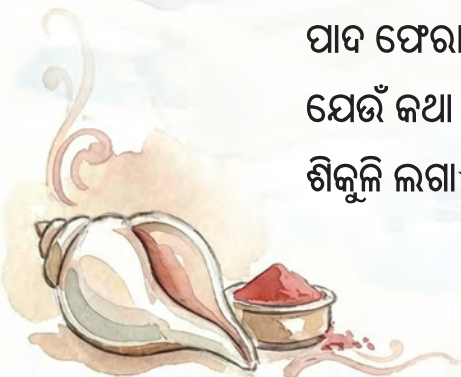

They built a world from faith and fatigue, stitched my future with threads of prayer.

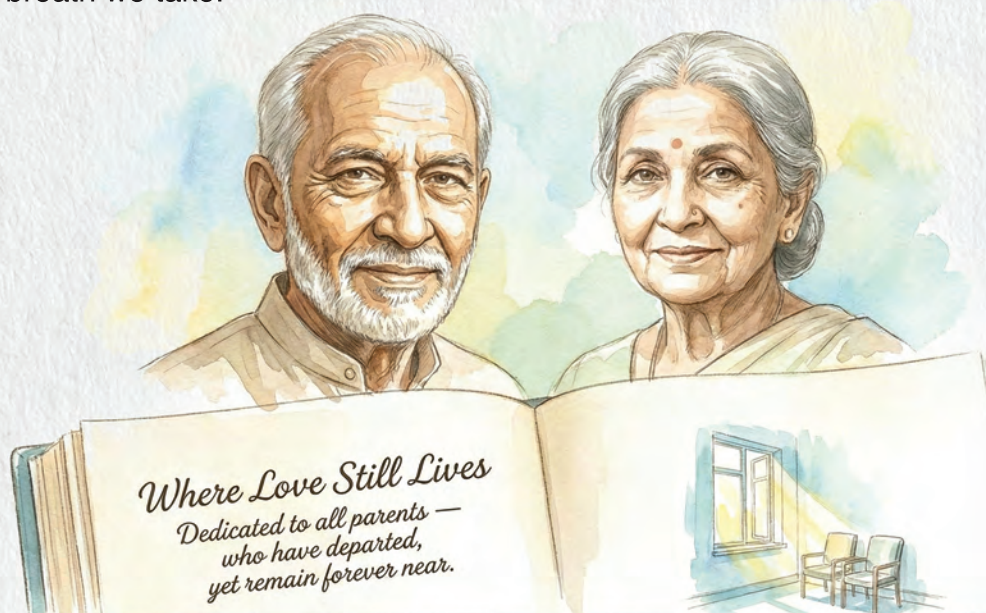
I miss her in the small things — the way tea tasted of warmth,

they just change their address from earth to the heart

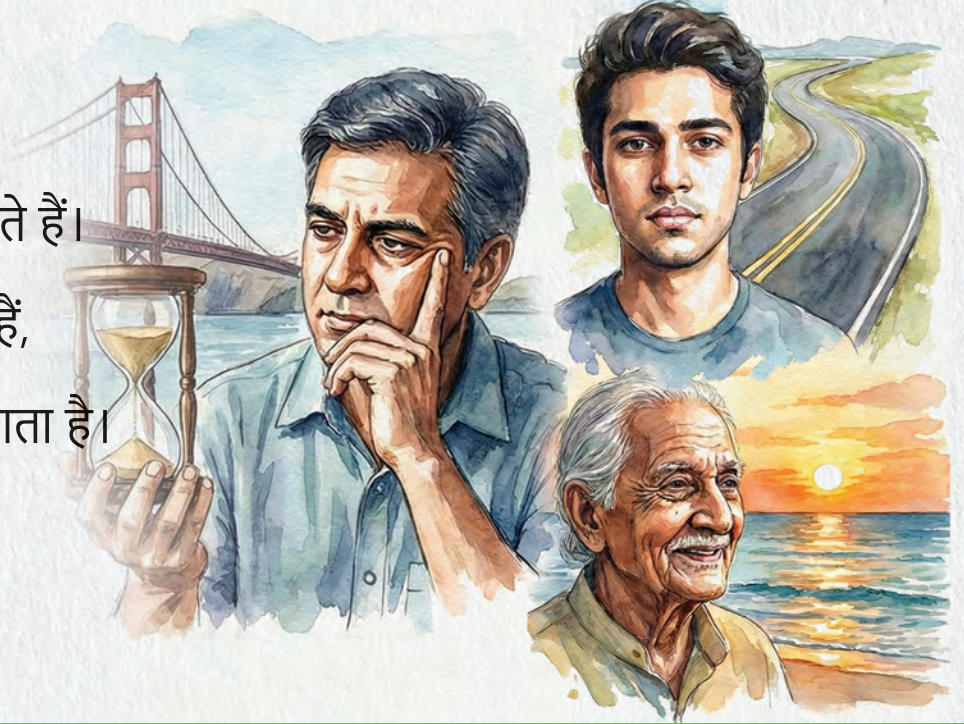

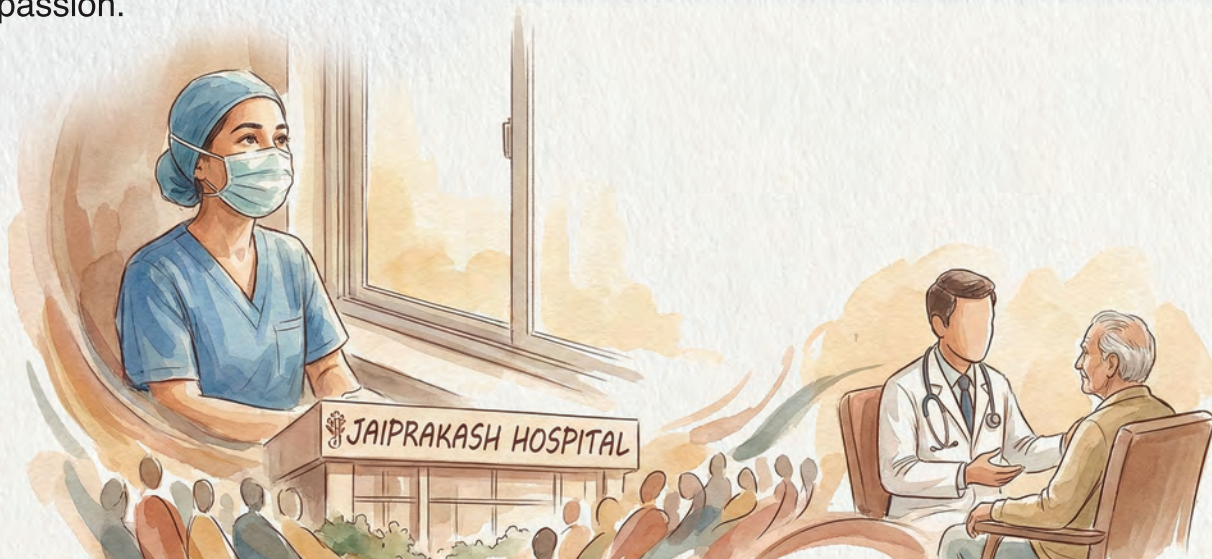
MY JOURNEY AFTER JOINED IN JAIPRAKASH HOSPITAL
